### THE CEREMONY ROOM



## The most versatile of the Cygnet Suite rooms, it transforms easily from a ceremony venue, into a dining room and then to a dance floor.

Sunkissed wooden beams frame the room and mismatched chairs form uniform lines, leaving space to walk the aisle. The Ceremony Room is the perfect space for a wedding ceremony for up to 65 guests.

### THE CROMWELL ROOM & SNUG



# Ironically named after Oliver Cromwell's troops as they burnt down the original mill, the building was rebuilt in 1647 and still stands today.

The room offers distinct rustic furniture and working Inglenook fireplaces, making it a beautifully cosy setting for an intimate event. Plus the additional snug presenting an optimal spot for an evening reception or daytime refreshments.

The room is wheelchair accessible through your very own side door.

While the Cromwell room is licensed for wedding ceremonies for up to 30 guests, it is also a great space for any occasion including baby showers, engagements, birthdays and other celebrations.
